If you have questions about breastfeeding after your baby is born, call your health department, or the Breastfeeding Helpline. You may be able to schedule an appointment for a breastfeeding counselor to help you "latch-on" your baby.

Clients who are WIC participants may be able to borrow a pump from the health department. In cases where mothers are separated from their infants for a medical reason, Georgia Medicaid will pay for the loan of a breast pump.
