What is MRSA?

- Staph are bacteria that cause skin infections
- MRSA is a type of staph that is resistant to the commonly used antibiotics for skin infections

Skin infections caused by staph:

folliculitis



furuncle



carbuncle



abscess



To prevent skin infections with the Staph germ

- Get examined in medical if you have any sores that are swollen, red, painful, or draining
